CONFERENCE HIGHLIGHTS


The 2022 ECCC Scientific program was organized for a 3-day program from 13th - 15th May at the Intercontinental Hotel, Event Centre, Dubai Festival City. The conference was hosted as a fully physical conference however few of the sessions were also broadcasted virtually for some of our virtual Attendees from other countries.

The conference received a total **1563** attendees, from **53** countries, **3** Federations participation, **36** Endorsing Societies, **8** Media Partners & **1** Conference Collaborator who endorsed the conference of the 18th ECCC Conference 2022.

The agenda of the scientific program was as such covering the **3** Full day program which included a total of **7** parallel Tracks each day covering a total of 295 Lecture topics including the following subspecialties tracks within 68 Sessions.

The companies supporting the conference also actively supported and conducted the following activities during the 3 days program.




The conference received poster Abstracts for onsite presentation. A combined total of **33 abstracts** were received for the **ECCC 2022** who presented onsite.

The NCS Journal confirmed and approved **5 abstracts** for publication in the Neurocritical care journal.

A total of **246** faculties from across the globe joined us with their invaluable contribution towards a strong scientific program for 2022 conference. The Conference also received few faculty members virtually who were unable to join Onsite. There were **197** Speakers who join us physically onsite and **49** Speakers who joined us virtually. There were Faculties from **37** countries who participated of which 94 were international speakers, **63** were Regional Speakers and 89 local faculties participated.








ECCC 2022 Physical to Virtual Attendance in %




Registration Overview by Region

Registration by Region ECCC 2022- International




ECCC 2022 Registration by Region - Regional
